With reference to your letter no.SML/BBL/17-18/06 dated 01.08.2017 on the above mentioned subject, I am directed to say that the State Environment Impact Assessment Authority, Odisha have considered the extension of time period of Environmental Clearance for the above project in its meeting held on 19.08.2017.

Considering the information/documents furnished by the project proponent, the State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) as per order passed by the Hon'ble High Court, Delhi as well as Odisha and considerations of the relevant documents submitted by the project proponent have recommended for extension of validity period of environmental clearance granted to M/s Shree Metaliks in the district of Keonjhar upto 30 years or period of lease whichever is less.

The SEIAA, Odisha after due consideration under the provisions of EIA Notification 2006 and 2009 and subsequent amendments thereto and as per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Odisha hereby grant extension of time period of
